SPECTATOR NOTES

- Wristbands must be WORN on your wrist, not attached to bags or purses.
- Broken wristbands will not be replaced, new band must be purchased.
- NO NOISE MAKERS OR ANYTHING THAT WOULD BE CONSIDERED DISRUPTIVE TO THE TEAMS PLAYING ON ANY COURT

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Players and coaches will be allowed to enter each playing site with their Showcase Bag Tag provided at Check-In. **Please be sure to have the players secure their tag to their backpacks and coaches to some sort of bag.**
- **Teams in the Youth Showcase will have a minimum of 2 matches on Sunday.** Teams that lose on Sunday will ref the next match on their court (unless it is the final match of the day on that court).
- **The Mizuno Showcase is played over three days with a single elimination on Sunday.** Teams that lose on Sunday will ref the next match on their court (unless it is the final match of the day on that court).
- Some teams that are scheduled to play at 9am on Sunday will officiate the 8am match on their court. Please check the schedule carefully.

Entry to facility for the start of each wave will be as follows:

Coaches/Players – 45 minutes before first scheduled match of each wave

Spectators – 30 minutes before first scheduled match of each wave

To alleviate some of the congestion, we ask that all teams and families clear the court area if you are not playing or officiating.

Wristbands

Please be advised that the number of people allowed into the facilities could change prior to the event and that this may require us to change the ticketing policy to limit attendance. This would be out of our control and would be based on governmental regulations.

Please note:

- All sales are final. No refunds will be given for any reason.
- Purchased Wristbands must be displayed each time you enter the venue.
- Wristbands must be worn on the wrist. Wristbands on purses or backpacks will not be recognized.
- Lost, forgotten, or stolen wristbands must be re-purchased. We do not replace weekend passes because you cut the wristband off.
- Children 10 and under are free. They do not require a wristband.

Live Streaming

We do not have live streaming for this event.

Food & Drink at all Sites

There is to be **no outside food or drink allowed in any of the facilities.** Please leave all coolers and food outside the facilities. A picnic or area may be designated to keep your coolers. In the event an area is not designated we ask that coolers and food remain in your vehicle. Absolutely no food is allowed on the Sport Court surfaces or court areas in any of the facilities. Teams which violate this rule will be removed from the event venue. Spectators who violate this rule will be asked to leave the facility.

Tournament Souvenirs

NetLynx Apparel will have a variety of tournament T-shirts and other items available for sale on site.

Attendance Waiver

All persons attending this event are bound by and accept the following:

1. NetLynx Sports are private events. Absolutely NO outside commercial photographers or professional videography is permitted at any time.
2. **No artificial noise makers are permitted** at NetLynx Sports Events. This includes the use of “boom boxes” or speakers projecting music during team warm-ups or competition.
3. The sharing of any admittance credentials or wristbands is strictly prohibited and will result in the confiscation of those credentials and expulsion of the persons involved for the remainder of the event.
4. Warning: Risk of injury from flying objects incidental to the sport of volleyball may occur at this event. Attend at your own risk. Please pay close attention to your surroundings and be always on alert, especially during active play.

Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Consent for Use of Likeness

In consideration of being admitted to any NetLynx Sports events (or simply, “Event”) and allowed to participate in any way in the Event, related events, and activities, I acknowledge and agree that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in this event is significant; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my attendance or participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated terms and conditions for participation, provided if I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring the hazard to the attention of the nearest staff immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS the Event, NetLynx Inc, and all their officers, officials, agents and employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event (RELEASEES), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. By participating in the Event, whether as a player, coach, staff member, spectator, or other registrant: I agree the Event and its authorized representatives may film, videotape, and photograph me, and the Event and its authorized representatives may have my name, image, picture, likeness, voice, and biographical information otherwise recorded, in any media during the Event by any Event authorized representative under the conditions specified by the Event (Images).
6. I grant the Event, NetLynx Sports., with no financial or other compensation due to me, full right, and license to use, and to authorize third parties to use, in all media, the Images for: (1) news and information purposes, (2) promotion of the specific competition(s) in which I participate as a player, coach, staff member, spectator or other registrant, (3) promotion of the Sport, and (4) promotion of the Event.
7. I agree to abide by the USAV Code of Conduct, or a Code of Conduct published by another sponsoring organization (JVA, AAU, etc.) of the Event.”

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, AND CONSENT FOR USE OF LIKENESS, UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY ATTENDING THE EVENT OR PARTICIPATING IN IT, AND AGREE TO THIS RELEASE, ASSUMPTION AND CONSENT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

For Parents/Guardians of Participant of Minor Age (Under 18 at Time of Participation):

I certify, as a parent/guardian with legal responsibility for the participant, do consent and agree to his/her release as provided above of all the Releasees, and for myself, my heirs, assigns, and next of kin, I release and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from any and all liability incidents to my minor child’s involvement in or participation in this event as provided above, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

In addition to agreeing to the Waivers above, I agree to abide by the PROHIBITED ITEMS List, which includes but is not necessarily limited to:

- Weapons of any type
- Coolers

- Personal transportation devices (hoverboard, skateboards, etc.)
- Oversized bags or luggage
- Outside food and drink
- All tobacco products (including e-cigarettes and vaping products)
- Alcoholic beverages
- **Loud noise makers, including music sound systems not using headphones.**
- Balloons
- Other items as determined by the event staff.

Parents of minors must agree to the all the stipulations stated above as a condition of admission to any NetLynx Sports Event.

COVID-19 Protocols

The following set of protocols regarding Covid-19 are outlined below. With the COVID-19 situation being highly fluid, these protocols could change at any point in time, up to and including during the event.

Winnebago County requires all persons while indoors MUST wear a face mask that covers their mouth and nose at all times. If you are outdoors and able to social distance, it is not mandatory.

It is not unusual for someone from the County Health Department to come and do a “surprise” inspection during public events and we all want to do our part to ensure they have no reason to close down the event, so we are asking everyone to please police yourselves and your teams.

Playing Sites Protocols:

- Winnebago County requires a Face Mask must be always worn COVERING YOUR MOUTH AND NOSE this applies to everyone (even while actively participating on the courts).
- **Please police yourselves and your teams. We do not want to be the mask police.**
- Face Shields are not an acceptable alternative for players due to safety concerns. A coach may wear a face shield in addition to their face mask.
- All coaches and players on the bench must wear their face mask over their nose and mouth.
- Face Shields may be worn IN ADDITION to their face mask.
- Hand sanitizers will be strategically placed throughout other public areas.

Competition and Social Distancing Protocols:

- No handshaking before or after matches. All teams will wave.
- Teams and spectators **WILL NOT** rotate sides of the court. They will stay on the same side throughout the entire match.
- **There will be no tie breaking playoff matches at any level or age group.** The following tie breaking procedure will be utilized based on Match%, Head-to-Head, Set %, & Point %.
- Face masks are to be always worn. This applies to everyone in the facility. There are no exceptions to this rule unless it is medical release stating so. **Again, you MUST police yourselves.**
- Drinking fountains in the facilities will be shutdown. We suggest teams/players bring extra water in their bags. No outside coolers allowed.
- **Teams are responsible for their own warm-up balls.**
- Teams will be responsible for shagging your own volleyballs for warmups. If your team is waiting to warmup you will need to stand off to the side of the court and wait.
- The scorer’s table will be equipped with hand sanitizer and wipes.
- ***Officiating teams will be responsible for wiping down the score table etc. upon completion of their officiating duties with provided wipes and disposing of any trash even if they didn’t generate it.***
- **Teams will supply their own pens/pencils for all matches. These will not be provided.**

- Two people will be permitted at the scorer's table. *One person will keep the scoresheet and the other will flip the score. We will not libero track.*
- Officiating teams will provide 2 score persons at the table (score & **flipper**), 2 lines judges, and one R2 for each match-for younger age groups please make sure there is a Coach observing if a player is the R2 to ensure there is consistency and if questions arise.
- **Please do not bring food and drink to the score table** (if you must, please just bring water).
- It is recommended the R2 use a handheld whistle.
- Teams who are off or players who are not officiating should leave the court area and find a place in other parts of the building to wait for their next match.
- Spectators will be allowed at each court. Please remove your chairs when your team is not playing to allow others to have a place to watch. Please remember to social distance from those not a part of your household when seated in a group.
- Spectators may also stand in open areas providing they maintain social distance from others.
- Once your team is done playing for the day or in the tournament and your referee assignment has been completed, you should leave the playing area. Sunday will be the highest occupancy day and we need to do our part and minimize the number of persons in anyone playing area.
- **Teams are discouraged from going to other courts to watch "sister" teams play.**
- While there are no current limitations on the maximum number of people allowed per family, we recommend that no more than 2 adults per player attend as spectators when possible.
